- ▶ ADEA is the voice of—and advocate for—dental education:
 - ▷ ADEA has and will continue to lead efforts to secure federal reimbursement for oral health care services provided within institutions or in community-based settings through graduate medical education (GME), Medicaid and other access initiatives, and the Ryan White CARE Act
 - ▷ ADEA advocates for federal funding for Title VII programs that build capacity to address shortages of oral health care providers and enhance diversity among providers
- ▶ ADEA is the only source for comparative data regarding student demographics, credentials, and attitudes; vacant faculty positions; faculty salaries; and much more
- ▶ Every dental school has a voice in forging the direction of dental education. Individual representatives from each school sit in the ADEA House of Delegates, ADEA Council of Faculties, and ADEA Council of Deans. These entities provide the only means for institutions to affect the future direction of dental education.
- ▶ The ADEA Commission on Change and Innovation in Dental Education (ADEA CCI) is the only entity researching and recommending bold new directions for curricular reform
- ▶ ADEA's partnership with the Association of American Medical Colleges through MedEdPORTAL and the Summer Medical and Dental Education Program not only increases interdisciplinary educational exchange of resources and ideas, but also increases the pipeline of students choosing dentistry as a career
