Requirements to Apply to Program

English Language Proficiency

- ✘ Must be proficient in the English language
- ✘ Applicants whose native language is not English are required to take the TOEFL

National Board Dental Examination Requirements

- ✘ Program requires passage of NBDE Parts I and II to be considered for admission
- ✘ Submit official National Board Dental scores to program after submitting ADEA CAAPID application

Letter of Evaluation

- ✘ Program accepts up to three Letters of Evaluation
- ✘ Program prefers one Letter of Evaluation to come from dean of dental school from which applicant graduated

Transcripts and Evaluations

- ✘ Applicant must submit to ADEA CAAPID a detailed evaluation by either ECE or WES

Application Fees

- ✘ Send application fee to program (not to ADEA CAAPID) only if requested to do so by program
- ✘ Non-refundable application fee of \$250 made payable to UMDNJ (NO CASH ACCEPTED)

Other Documents That Should Be Sent Directly to Program (not to ADEA CAAPID)

- ✘ Send 2" x 2" photograph to program (not to ADEA CAAPID) after submitting ADEA CAAPID application

Additional Requirements

- ✘ Bench test fee of \$125 will be required from those applicants invited to interview at UMDNJ-New Jersey Dental School
