HEALTH PROVIDER SHORTAGE AREAS

The Health Resources and Services Administration has determined that there are 436 Dental Health Professional Shortage Areas in California as of August 2018. This means that over to 1.1 million residents lack adequate access to dental care providers.

Funding for oral health training under Title VII health professions programs can reduce the number of those in need by expanding the oral health workforce in general, pediatric and public health dentistry.

FEDERAL GRANTS AND HEALTH CARE SPENDING

Total state grant funding from the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research (NIDCR): \$19,849,554.

Total state grant funding for Oral Health Workforce Development Grants from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA): \$2,165,351.

Federal Medicaid spending: \$52,523,329,199.

Federal CHIP spending: \$2,421,899,000.

DENTAL SERVICES UNDER CALIFORNIA MEDICAID

California Medicaid covers early and periodic screening, diagnostic and treatment dental services for children under the age of 21 and a comprehensive mix of dental services for adults.

The state has expanded access to Medicaid under the Affordable Care Act to cover adults who earn incomes up to 138% of the federal poverty level.

MEMBER COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

ADEA member dental schools and allied dental schools operate clinics that serve their local communities, and many participate in outreach efforts to provide care to underserved communities.
