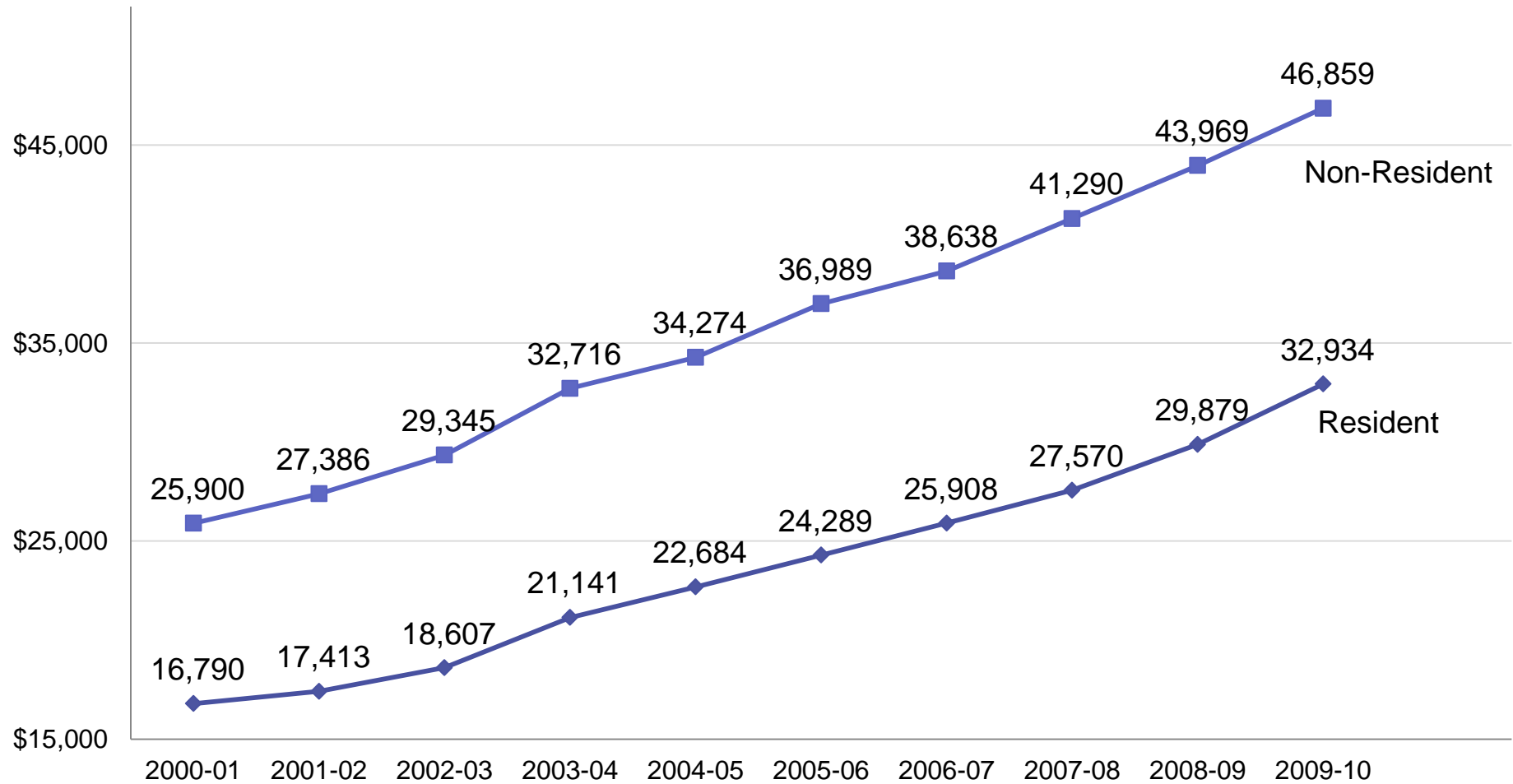




Average U.S. Dental School Tuition and Fees for Resident and Non-Resident First-Year Students, 2000 to 2010 (Current Dollars)

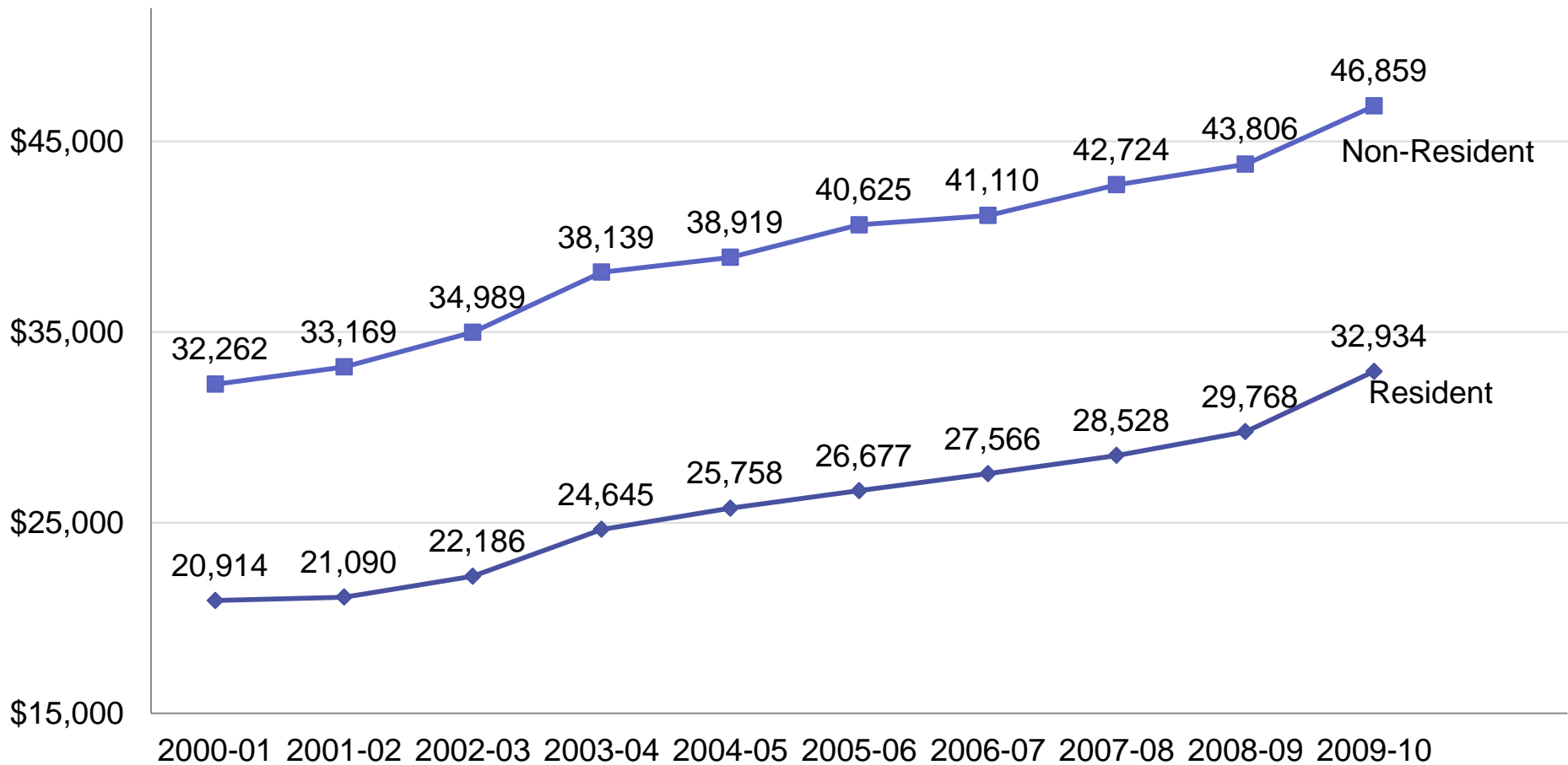

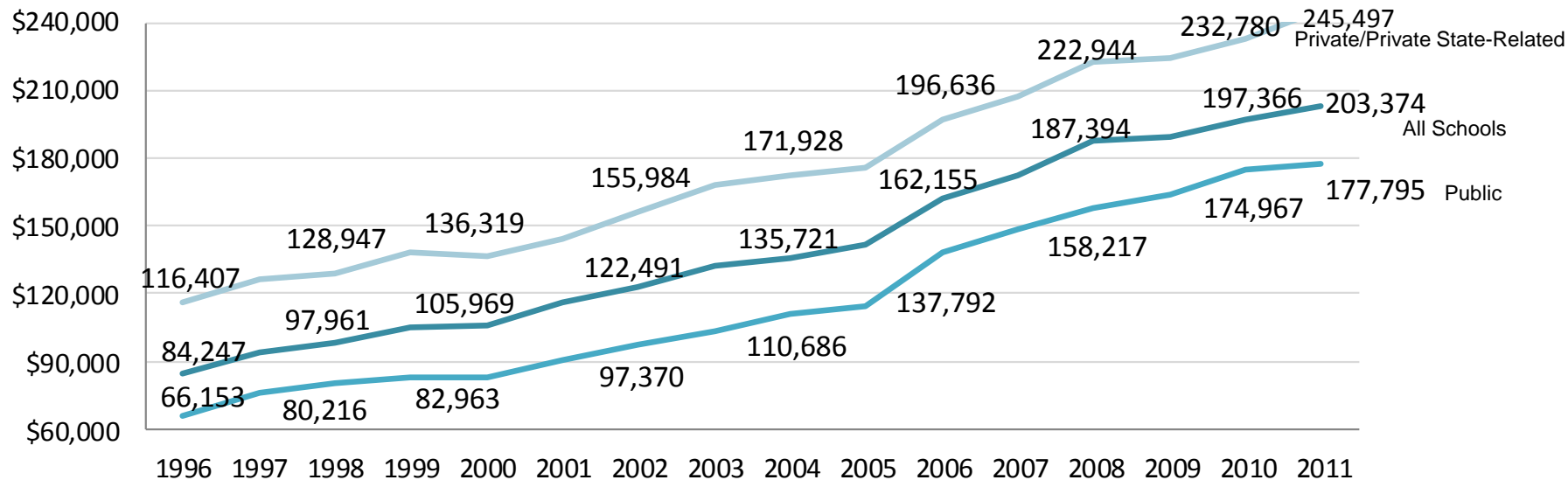

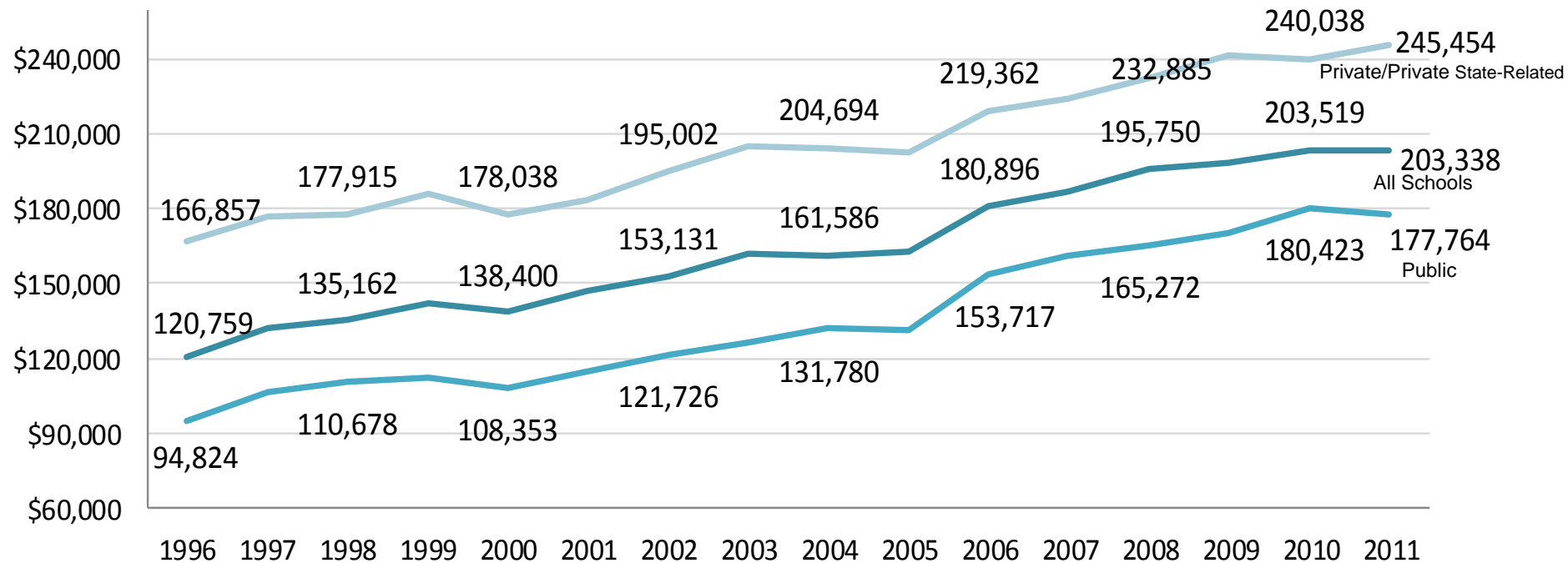

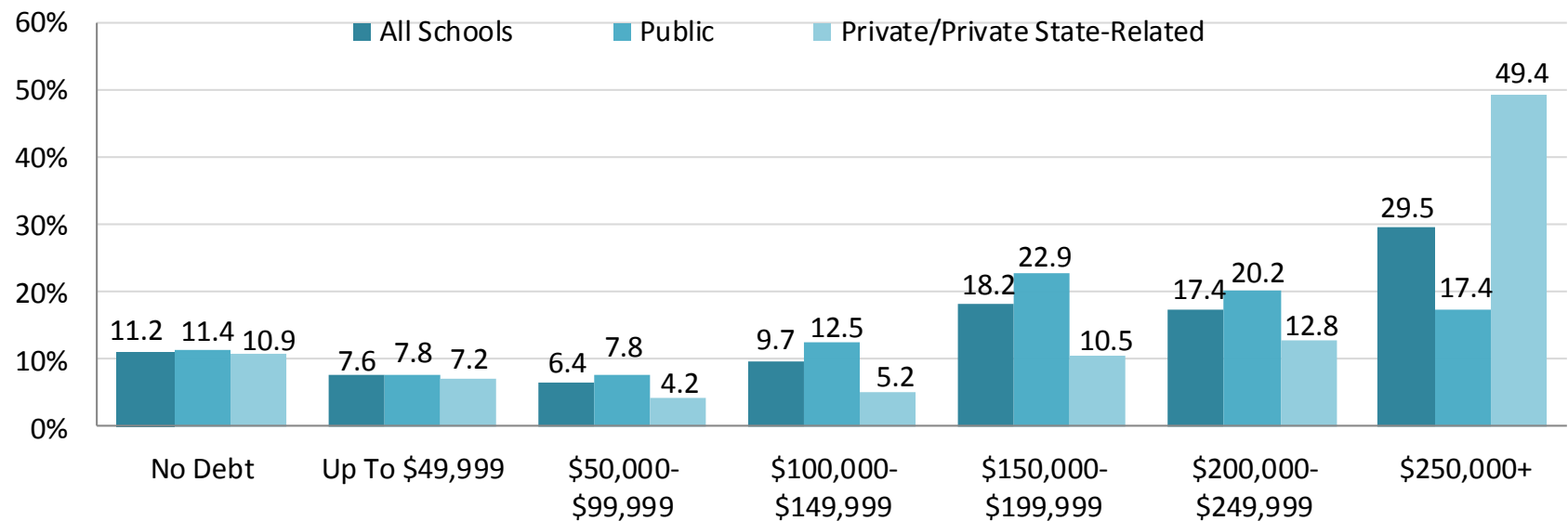
